Prevailing in Prayer

Luke 10:19 (NKJV)

Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

4. Faith Factor Four — Victorious Praying: ELIMINATES STRONGHOLDS

2 Chronicles 30:26-27 & 31:1-2 (NKJV)

So there was great joy in Jerusalem, for since the time of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel, *there had been* nothing like this in Jerusalem. Then the priests, the Levites, arose and blessed the people, and their voice was heard; and their prayer came *up* to His holy dwelling place, to heaven. [Chapter 31:1-2] Now when all this was finished, all Israel who were present went out to the cities of Judah and broke the *sacred* pillars in pieces, cut down the wooden images, and threw down the high places and the altars—from all Judah, Benjamin, Ephraim, and Manasseh—until they had utterly destroyed them all.

Ruling in Prayer

Revelation 2:26-28 (MSG)

5. Faith Factor Five — Victorious Praying: ENCOMPASSES NATIONS

2 Kings 19:19 (NKJV)

Now therefore, O LORD our God, I pray, save us from his [King Sennacherib’s] hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that You *are* the LORD God, You alone.

Psalms 2:8 (NKJV)

Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations *for* Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth *for* Your possession.

6. Faith Factor Six — Victorious Praying: ENLISTS HEAVEN

2 Chronicles 32:20-22 (NKJV)

Now... King Hezekiah and the prophet Isaiah, the son of Amoz, prayed and cried out to heaven. Then the LORD sent an angel who cut down every mighty man of valor, leader, and captain... of Assyria... Thus the LORD saved Hezekiah... from the hand of Sennacherib... and from the hand of all *others*, and guided them on every side.

Revelation 5:7-10 (CEV)

As a group (in your prayer cluster) pray for any major local, national or global issues where you would like to see the enemy “frustrated” and “routed” through your prayers.



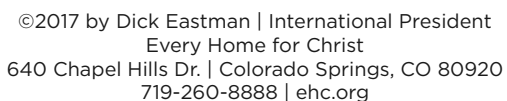
