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#### ***1 Timothy 1:18-19 (NKJV)***

This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good warfare, having faith and a good conscience, which some having rejected, concerning the faith have suffered shipwreck...

#### ***2 Timothy 2:3-4 (NKJV)***

You therefore must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of *this* life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.

### ***Genesis 32:25-28 (AMPC)***

And when [the Man] saw that He did not prevail against [Jacob], He touched the hollow of his thigh; and Jacob's thigh was put out of joint as he wrestled with Him. Then He said, Let Me go, for day is breaking. But [Jacob] said, I will not let You go unless You declare a blessing upon me. [The Man] asked him, What is your name? And [in shock of realization, whispering] he said, Jacob [supplanter, schemer, trickster, swindler]!



And He said, Your name shall be called no more Jacob [supplanter], but Israel [contender with God]; for you have contended *and* have power with God and with men and have prevailed.

***Colossians 1:27-29 (NIV)***

## WARFARE CLUSTER - INSIGHT ONE

### *Contending*

Prayer is the battleground where each battle will be won.

## PART 1

### *Wrestling in Prayer*

#### ***Ephesians 6:10-12 (AMPC)***

In conclusion, be strong in the Lord [be empowered through your union with Him]; draw your strength from Him [that strength which His boundless might provides]. Put on God's whole armor [the armor of a heavy-armed soldier which God supplies], that you may be able successfully to stand up against [all] the strategies *and* the deceits of the devil. For we are not wrestling with flesh and blood [contending only with physical opponents], but against the despotisms, against the powers, against [the master spirits who are] the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spirit forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) sphere.

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#### ***Hosea 12:3-4 (NLT)***

## WARFARE CLUSTER - INSIGHT TWO

### *Wrestling*

To wrestle is to engage an opponent directly in face-to-face conflict. Our enemy Satan must be confronted directly in our spiritual warfare. Because it is essential that the believer understands the tactics [e.g. the wiles or methods] of the enemy, it is vital to rely on the supernatural empowerment of the Holy Spirit and the authority of God's Word to gain the victory.

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## WARFARE CLUSTER - INSIGHT THREE

### *Warring*

Warring is to engage the enemy in every subsequent battle with consistency and courage.

## PART 3

### *Travailing in Prayer*

#### DEFINITIONS

From the Latin *Tripalium*: “An instrument of torture.”  
“Hardship; trouble; labor pains; pains of childbirth.”

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#### VOICES OF PRAYER

There is a marked absence of travail [in the church today]. There is much phrasing, but little pleading. Prayer has become a soliloquy instead of a passion. The powerlessness of the church needs no other explanation... To be prayerless is to be both passionless and powerless.

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#### ***Romans 8:26-27 (KJV)***

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

## FOUR REALITIES ABOUT TRAVAIL

1. Travail Precedes birth.

### ***Revelation 12:1-2 (NLT)***

Then I witnessed in heaven an event of great significance. I saw a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon beneath her feet, and a crown of twelve stars on her head. She was pregnant, and she cried out because of her labor pains and the agony of giving birth.

### ***Isaiah 66:6-8 (NLT)***

“What is all the commotion in the city? What is that terrible noise from the Temple? It is the voice of the LORD taking vengeance against his enemies. Before the birth pains even begin, Jerusalem gives birth to a son. Who has ever seen anything as strange as this? Who ever heard of such a thing? Has a nation ever been born in a single day? Has a country ever come forth in a mere moment? But by the time Jerusalem’s birth pains begin, her children will be born.”



## VOICES OF PRAYER

Just as the contractions of a woman's uterus herald the beginning of labor, there are times when God's Spirit stirs our souls to seasons of intense travail. We must travail in prayer until God's purposes are birthed.

### 2. Travail Provokes     pain    .

#### ***Jeremiah 4:31 (NKJV)***

"For I have heard a voice as of a woman in labor, The anguish as of her who brings forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion bewailing herself; she spreads her hands, *saying*, 'Woe *is* me now, for my soul is weary...'"

#### ***Galatians 4:18-19 (NKJV)***

...it is good to be zealous in a good thing always, and not only when I am present with you. My little children, for whom I labor in birth again [KJV: travail in birth] until Christ is formed in you...

### 3. Travail Produces     tears    .

#### ***Hebrews 5:5-7 (NKJV)***

So also Christ did not glorify Himself to become High Priest, but *it was* He who said to Him: "You are My Son. Today I have begotten You." As *He* also *says* in another *place*: "You *are* a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek"; who, in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear...



4. Travail Promises pleasure.

***John 16:20-21 (NLT)***

I tell you the truth, you will weep and mourn over what is going to happen to me, but the world will rejoice. You will grieve, but your grief will suddenly turn to wonderful joy. It will be like a woman suffering the pains of labor. When her child is born, her anguish gives way to joy because she has brought a new baby into the world.

***Psalms 126:5-6 (NKJV)***

Those who sow in tears Shall reap in joy. He who continually goes forth weeping, Bearing seed for sowing, Shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, Bringing his sheaves *with him*.

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## WARFARE CLUSTER - INSIGHT FOUR

### ***Thoughts***

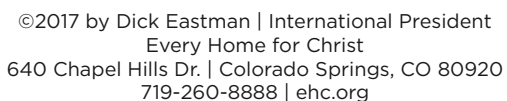
