IMPORTANT NOTE: The vast majority of the 2.9 billion gospel messages listed in the Literature Distributed column have been given home-by-home. In most EHC works, two gospel messages are given per home, one for adults and one for children. In some cases both messages are in the same booklet so would be noted as only one message in the above statistics. Not reflected above are the 159,089 Christ Groups (small house churches) formed in countries such as India, Nepal, Indonesia, etc., where there are few if any churches in many towns and villages. Also difficult to add to the statistics are home to home contacts for illiterates where cassette recordings have been played or "picture" visual aids, such as *The Heart of Man* chart, have been used to communicate the Gospel. For example, over 300,000 recorded messages have been taken by EHC workers to 100,000 predominately illiterate villages in South Asia.

x - All Others include other countries or projects where literature has been distributed, including:

1. Literature distributed in some countries that no longer have an EHC office;
2. Countries that had distribution, but no office;
3. Countries that had literature sent to missionaries and nationals from 1946-1953 in WLC's earliest years before the EHC campaign officially began in 1953.

* America, North - The majority of responses in the US and Canada go to local churches doing the distribution and results are not reported to the EHC office. Follow up is handled by those churches.

** Creative Access nations include Islamic and other so-called "closed" regions where, for security purposes, specific countries and statistics are not individually listed. Still, significant EHC activity is conducted.
