PRAYER!The Fountainhead of Creativity

(Part 1)

Jeremiah 33:3 (MSG) Call to me and I will answer you. I'll tell you marvelous and wondrous things that you could never figure out on your own.
Romans 4:17 (NIV) As it is written: "I have made you a father of many nations." He is our father in the sight of God, in whom he believed—the God who gives life to the dead and calls things that are not as though they were.

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.

John 14:12-13 (NLT)

The truth is, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father.

See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland.

Mark 4:5-11 (MSG)

Some [seed] fell in the gravel; it sprouted quickly but didn't put down roots, so when the sun came up it withered just as quickly. Some fell in the weeds; as it came up, it was strangled among the weeds and nothing came of it. Some fell on good earth and came up with a flourish, producing a harvest exceeding his wildest dreams. "Are you listening to this? Really listening?" When they were off by themselves, those who were close to him, along with the Twelve, asked



about the stories. He told them, "You've been given insight into God's kingdom—you know how it works. But to those who can't see it yet, everything comes in stories, creating readiness, nudging them toward receptive insight.

PRAYER APPLICATION (Reflect and Respond)

Then pray that your "picture" will become a reality with Romans 4:17 (NKJV) as a basis—"God... gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did."

Then David presented his son Solomon with the plans for The Temple complex: porch, storerooms, meeting rooms, and the place for atoning sacrifice. He turned over the plans for everything that God's Spirit had brought to his mind: the design of the courtyards, the arrangements of rooms, and the closets for storing all the holy things.

TEN WAYS to Make Your Prayer Life More Meaningful and Exciting

(Part 1)

John 16:23-24 (NLT)

Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

10. FINISH

Acts 10:1-4 (NIV)

At Caesarea there was a man named Cornelius, a centurion in what was known as the Italian Regiment. He and all his family were devout and God-fearing; he gave generously to those in need and prayed to God regularly. One day... he had a vision. He distinctly saw an angel of God, who came to him and said... "Your prayers and gifts to the poor have come up as a memorial offering before God."

PRAYER APPLICATION

(Reflect and Respond)

If you find yourself sometimes lacking joy in personal prayer, pray as David did in Psalm 51:12, "Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation..." (KJV). Ask God to help you "finish well" as an intercessor by not giving up no matter the discouragements that may come your way.
